

## Removing Microsoft Internet Explorer 9

- 1. Click on the Windows start button.
- 2. Next, go to the Control Panel



## 3. Click on Programs.



If you do not see Programs, click on Programs and Features.



## 4. Click on View installed updates



5. Use the search feature in the upper right hand corner and type the word Internet in box.
